Dear Mr Gardener,

As discussed at Maidenhead Police station on the 17th March 2017 I can confirm that the investigation relating to the actions and decisions of the Valuation Office Agency (VOA) and South Bucks District Council (SBDC) will not be investigated by Thames Valley Police at this time. This is because this is a civil matter between you and the VOA and SBDC. I understand that you have made contact with the VOA and the Valuation Tribunal Service (VTS) about the alleged fraud and I recommend you continue to follow their procedures for making a complaint.

You can contact the adjudicator for VOA to look into your complaint. The adjudicator is a fair and unbiased referee whose recommendations are independent. The contact details are listed below.

If you are still unhappy with the outcome may I recommend you contact your local MP to ask them to refer your complaint to the Parliamentary Ombudsman. The ombudsman is independent of government and their service is free of charge.
